Organic Climbing Under Construction of New Manufacturing Facility



The Organic Climbing LLC manufacturing facility is now under construction. Located in the Moshannon Valley Regional Business Park, this new facility will be the new home to a company that was once located in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Josh Helke is the founder, owner and president of the company.

"We are pleased with the construction work to date and we are looking forward to occupying our new building in early fall," said Mr. Helke. Organic Climbing was first started in Wyoming in 2004. The company manufac-

tures high quality bouldering crash pads for rock climbing enthusiasts from around the world. Backpacks, clothing, and tote bags are also made by the employees of the company. "We are proud to be an American manufacturer," said Helke.

Organic Climbing LLC has been a business tenant of the MVEDP's Regional Business Center since October 2010. Financing for the new manufacturing facility was put together by Mr. Helke using loan funding from Juniata Valley Bank, private funds, and a state loan through the PA Industrial Development Authority (PIDA) in the amount of \$800,000.00. Since the MVEDP is a Certified Economic Development Organization, we were able to secure this loan for the company in late 2017 at an interest rate of 2%.

Philipsburg-Osceola Area School District Helping Students Learn About Career Opportunities Here

On Wednesday, May 23rd, 130 students in Grade 10 visited five businesses located within the Moshannon Valley Regional Business Park to learn about how those businesses operate and what job opportunities are available there. P-O was successful in securing a small grant through the TEAM PA Foundation's Career Readiness Mini-Grant Program for this effort. Linda Hockey and Justin Hazelton of the school district were instrumental in securing the grant and organizing the tour of the companies.

The P-O School district's effort to help students learn about local companies and job opportunities was a feature story in the Team Pennsylvania Foundation's February news publication. This publication is a state-wide news source.

A great big thanks to Advanced Powder Products, PMG Pennsylvania Corporation, Diamondback Truck Covers, Organic Climbing, and the PA Department of Environmental Protection for opening their doors to the P-O students.

MVEDP Underway with Projects at the Enterprise Center



The Partnership is now underway with some very important projects that must be completed at the Enterprise Center. A loan of

\$77,500 from the PA Industrial Development Authority was secured for the project and the total cost of the improvements is estimated to be \$155,000.00.

Projects include: replacement of the main sewer line from the Enterprise Center to a Rush Township manhole, major rubber roof repairs, asphalt replacement and repairs, lighting upgrades and a new concrete floor in a 13,000 sf. area that was the home to Diamondback Truck Covers previously. The Partnership is also exploring the possibility of adding air conditioning to that space to make it more marketable to prospective business tenants.


MVEDP Adds New Marketing Video to Website





working at the companies located there. Never forget that at the time that we first developed this site in 2001, it was labeled a "field of dreams" by an area resident. And recall too that the MVEDP decided back then not to sell the land to the largest retailer in the world.

We can't say enough about how important it is for young people to secure the skills needed by area companies if they want to stay in this area. We are closely tracking the two vocational technical schools that serve our region: Clearfield County Career and Technology Center, and the Central PA Institute of Science & Technology. The most important thing is that their course offerings match the job market here.
