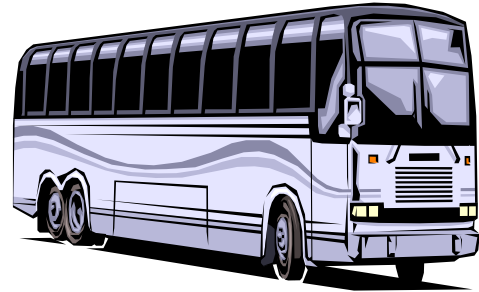

Bellefonte Historical Railroad

A non-profit, all volunteer organization; operates a Rail Diesel Car in excursion service over some 40 miles of track in the heart of Centre County. Trains depart each weekend afternoon from Memorial Day through the end of September from Bellefonte's handsomely restored Pennsylvania Railroad station. Boalsburg

Located 4 miles Southeast of State College, just off Route 322 this typical American village was settled by the Scotch-Irish in 1806. Boalsburg is the birthplace of Memorial Day, having been celebrated continually since 1864. The Boalsburg Village Conservancy has published a booklet, which deals with Boalsburg's claim to the birthplace of Memorial Day and contains a self-guided walking tour of the village. Happy Valley Vineyard & Winery

Happy Valley Vineyard was established in 1999 with an initial three acres of vines on land initially settled for farming in the 1850's. The vineyard has more than tripled in size at 9.5 acres. The winery was built in the summer of 2010. Our gorgeous timber frame tasting room was completed in January of 2013. Wines can be purchased by the glass, the bottle, and case. Museum of Art

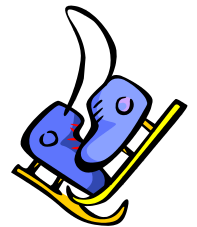
